The FB Committee has prepared these amendments based on feedback from the Massachusetts High School Football Coaches Association and has established a joint sub-committee with TMC. Our goal is to gather data from Administrators, Athletic Directors, and Coaches so we can appropriately represent the majority opinion regarding any modifications to the football format and tournament. Any changes would begin in the Fall of 2025.

Executive Summary bullets for attention:

- Realign football with the MIAA Tournament Philosophy maintain the integrity and importance of the regular season.
- Provide an equitable experience for all the student-athletes by eliminating consolation games and bye-weeks in November.
- Establish guidelines to ensure all divisions an equal path to the tournament by limiting the number of teams per division.
- Increase opportunities to schedule divisional opponents to build a team's power rating.
- Improve seeding accuracy by completing all rivalry and league games before the tournament.
- Create a higher standard to qualify for the tournament.
- Communicate the positive and negative aspects of the modifications.

MHSFCA Head Coaches Survey Results

- •274 Head Coaches were invited to participate via email and text message
- 237 Head Coaches responded from 236 schools (Cardinal Spellman has co-head coaches)
- •7 schools are currently looking for a new head coach
- Response rate was 88.7% (236 of 267)
- The results include the 237 responses we received from active head coaches
- •These results have been shared with the MIAA Football Committee, who will publish the total response from all school administers and Athletic Directors.




Should all football teams experience a 10game regular season without consolation games?






Do you think it is fair to require 76% of teams to play at least one consolation game or take a bye in November so others can advance to the tournament?





Has your program experienced a negative impact in participation, attitude and/or interest when confronted with playing consolation games?






Should the football tournament begin after the regular season (Thanksgiving), consistent with other MIAA sports?








Should teams be required to have a winning record to qualify for the playoffs?






Do you support the recommendation to establish a policy to limit the number of teams in each division to maintain an equal path and percentage of teams participating in the post-season?






If teams play a 10-game regular season and the maximum number of teams in a division is 40, would you support an 8-team tournament?






Which regular season and tournament format is best for Massachusetts high school football?
